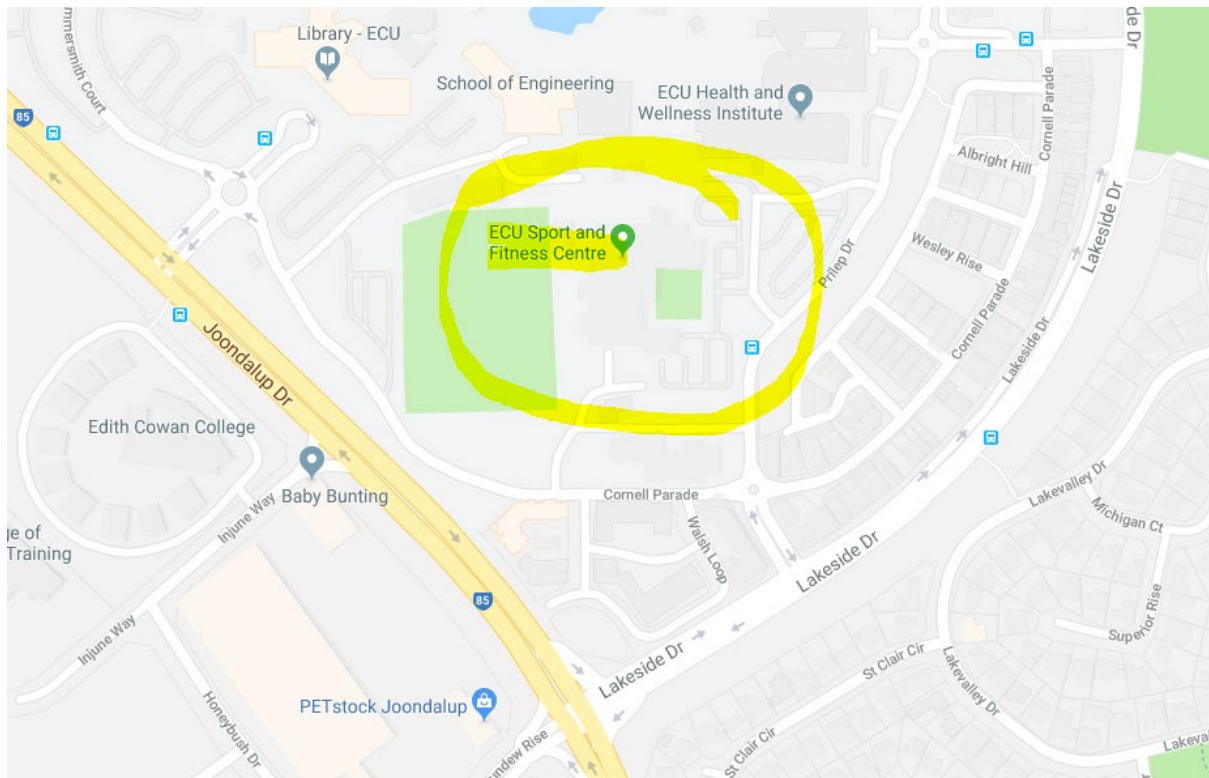

3 WHAT YOU WILL BE DOING

During judging each team will be visited by the judges. Each judging session will run for approximately 15 mins, and will give teams the opportunity to present and to respond to questions.

4 THE JUDGING PROCESS

In the week prior to the GameChanger Awards you will be sent a link to a short briefing on the judging process which you can watch at your leisure.

Judges are required to watch this video prior to attending on the day. It will make the commencement of judging proceed more efficiently.

Prior to the day you will be emailed the names of the others in your team so you know who to look for on the morning. You will also be emailed a link to a conflict of interest declaration form which you are also required to complete prior to arrival on the day.

4.1 On arrival

Celia Jordaarn, our Chief Judge, will brief you in the days' proceedings and you will be provided with a timetable and map so you can find the teams you are to judge on the day.

Judging must commence at 10am sharp and conclude by 2pm at the latest.

4.2 Judging Manual

A judging manual has been prepared to guide the judging process. You will be sent a copy of the judging manual with the link to the online briefing.

4.3 Judging System

Judging will take place with the assistance of a browser-based "WebApp" which can be accessed via your smartphone or tablet. You will be issued with a link to access the App prior to the day.

5 WORKING WITH CHILDREN CERTIFICATE

Judges are not required to have Working with Children certificates on the day.

6 VOLUNTEER SHIFTS

Volunteers are asked to work one of two shifts:

Morning: 8am – 12.30

Afternoon: 12pm – 4.30

7 DRESS CODE

You will be provided with a high-visibility vest to wear during the day so you are clearly identified as a judge.

Judges are also asked to dress neatly with clean white shirt and dark trousers or skirt.

8 WIFI

ECU will be providing WiFi. You will be issued with a password prior to the day.

9 REFRESHMENTS

Judges will be provided with a drinks/lunch voucher to spend at the food trucks.

10 PARKING

There is ample free parking behind the venue (see map)
