**2:00 pm - Judging finishes, start to pack up**

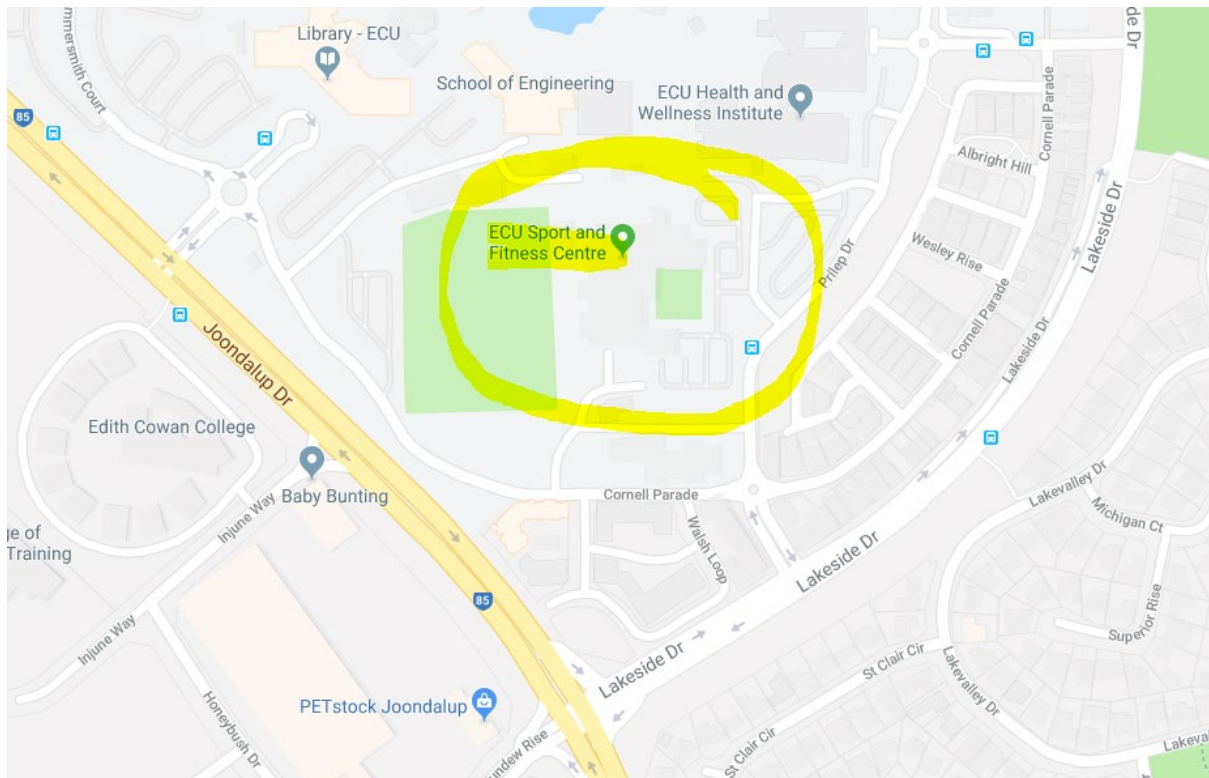
